NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS M1 NORTHBOUND & SOUTHBOUND (JUNCTIONS 23A-25)

At Highways England, we believe in a connected country, and our network makes these connections happen. In the East Midlands, we strive to improve our major roads and motorways, to keep people moving today and better tomorrow.

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential carriageway maintenance work to the M1, on the northbound and southbound carriageways, between junctions 23a and 25. We'll resurface sections of the carriageway and refresh road markings.

To minimise disruption to our customers, we'll work overnight while the road is less busy. This will ensure that our road network is as free-flowing as possible during the day. Work will be undertaken using lane closures and we will need to occasionally close a few slip roads.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother carriageway.

When will the work take place?

Works will take place overnight, from **Monday 15 March 2021 until Tuesday 20 April 2021**. We will stop work over the Easter weekend from Thursday 1 April and resume on Tuesday 6 April.

We will work Monday to Saturday, **between the hours of 8pm and 6am**. On Saturday and Sunday mornings, lane closures will be in place until approximately 9am.

In addition to this, we will also carry out works on Sunday 21 March.

During the works it will be necessary to have a few slip road closures, which will include the following at various dates:

- Junction 24a southbound exit slip road closed (diversion via junction 24)
- Junction 25 southbound entry slip road closed (diversion via junction 26)
- Junction 24 northbound entry slip road closed (diversion via A50 Sawley roundabout to junction 24)
- Junction 25 northbound exit slip road closed (diversion via junction 26)

During the slip road closures, we'll put in place a diversion route which we've agreed with the Local Authority. The slip roads will remain open outside of our working hours.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
